

Courier Receipt, Post Receipt, or Certificate of Posting

A **Courier Receipt**, however named, evidencing the receipt of goods for transport must:

1. Clearly indicate the **name of the courier service** and bear the stamp or signature of the named courier service. The place of issuance must align with the location specified in the credit as the point from which the goods are to be shipped.
2. Include a **date of pick-up or receipt** (or similar wording). This date will be treated as the **date of shipment**.
3. Satisfy any requirement for courier charges to be paid or prepaid. This condition can be met by a transport document issued by the courier service, provided it shows that the courier charges are for the account of a party other than the consignee.

A **Post Receipt** or **Certificate of Posting**, however named, evidencing the receipt of goods for transport must:

1. Bear a **stamp or signature** and be dated.
2. Clearly indicate that the issuance occurred at the place specified in the credit as the point of shipment.
3. Treat the **date of issuance** as the **date of shipment**.
